In this sample, erythrocyte uroporphyrinogen decarboxylase (UROD) activity was normal. While this finding rules out type II porphyria cutanea tarda, it does not eliminate the possibility of types I or III in which only hepatic UROD is deficient. If clinically indicated, consider urine porphyrins analysis.
