### Clinical & Interpretive

#### Clinical Information

Steroidogenic factor 1 (SF-1) is a transcription factor involved in the development of the anterior pituitary and is useful in the classification of pituitary adenomas. Expression of SF-1 is observed in gonadotropic hormone producing tumors (follicular stimulating or luteinizing hormone).

#### Reference Values

#### Interpretation

This test does not include pathologist interpretation; only technical performance of the stain. If interpretation is required order PATHC / Pathology Consultation for a full diagnostic evaluation or second opinion of the case.

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The positive and negative controls are verified as showing appropriate immunoreactivity and documentation is retained at Mayo Clinic Rochester. If a control tissue is not included on the slide, a scanned image of the relevant quality control tissue is available upon request, call 855-516-8404.

Interpretation of this test should be performed in the context of the patient's clinical history and other diagnostic tests by a qualified pathologist.

**Cautions**

Age of a cut paraffin section can affect immunoreactivity. Stability thresholds vary widely among published literature and are antigen-dependent. Best practice is for paraffin sections to be cut within 6 weeks.
