Supplies: Sarstedt Aliquot Tube, 5 mL (T914)

Collection Container/Tube: Red top (serum gel/SST are not acceptable)

Submission Container/Tube: Plastic vial

Specimen Volume: 1 mL

Collection Instructions:

- 1. Draw blood immediately before next scheduled dose.
- 2. Within 2 hours of collection, centrifuge and aliquot serum into a plastic vial.
