Supplies: Sarstedt Aliquot Tube, 5 mL (T914)

Collection Container/Tube: Red top (serum gel/SST are **not acceptable**)

Submission Container/Tube: Plastic vial

Specimen Volume: 1.5 mL **Collection Instructions:**

1. Draw blood immediately before the next scheduled dose.

2. Within 2 hours of collection centrifuge and aliquot serum into a plastic vial.
