Specimen Requirements:

Container/Tube:

Preferred: Gray top (potassium oxalate/sodium fluoride)

Acceptable: Lavender top (EDTA) or green top (sodium heparin)

Specimen Volume: 2 mL **Collection Instructions:**

1. Do not use alcohol to clean arm. Use an alternative, such as Betadine, to cleanse arm before collecting any specimen

for volatile testing.

2. Specimen must be sent in original tube. Do not aliquot.
