Supplies: Sarstedt Aliquot Tube, 5mL (T914)

**Collection Container/Tube:** 

**Preferred:** Serum gel **Acceptable:** Red top

Submission Container/Tube: Plastic vial

**Specimen Volume:** 0.6 mL **Collection Instructions:** 

1. Serum gel tubes should be centrifuged within 2 hours of collection.

2. Red-top tubes should be centrifuged, and the serum aliquoted into a plastic vial within 2 hours of collection.

Additional Information: Free prostate-specific antigen (PSA) can only be added on within 72 hours of performing total PSA. Specimen must have been shipped frozen.
