Anti-MDA5 antibodies are present in 7% to 35% of adult dermatomyositis. Clinical features consist of absent or mild muscle symptoms (clinical amyopathic dermatomyositis), rapidly progressive interstitial lung disease, specific mucocutaneous features of skin ulcerations and papules, oral ulcerations and arthritis.
