## Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) Antigen #9570

**EXPLANATION:** Effective November 29, 2010 this test will be replaced with a new test, #60550 Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) Molecular Detection, PCR.

**RECOMMENDED ALTERNATIVE TEST:** #60550, Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV) Molecular Detection, PCR

**USEFUL FOR:** Rapid identification of patients with respiratory syncytial virus (RSV) viral infections.

**METHOD**: Multiplex Real-Time Polymerase Chain Reaction (RT-PCR)

**REFERENCE VALUES:** Negative

**SPECIMEN REQUIREMENTS:** Nasopharyngeal swab (MML Supply T515) or throat swab (MML Supply T092). Nasopharyngeal aspirate, nasopharyngeal washing, bronchoalveolar lavage, or bronchial washings. Please send 0.5 mL refrigerate in a screw-capped plastic vial.

NOTE: Specimen source is required. Nasopharyngeal swabs or aspirates are the preferred specimen types for detection of RSV.

**CAUTIONS:** Given that influenza A, influenza B and RSV can cause identical appearing clinical illness, this test should typically be ordered as a panel (#60552). However, individual tests for influenza A and B (combined) (#60551) or RSV may also be ordered.
