# **Neopterin**

Test ID: FNEOS

## **Useful for:**

Increased levels of neopterin are found during impaired renal function and viral infection in transplant patients. Elevated levels are also indicators for conditions related to impaired cellular immunity.

### Methods:

Enzyme immunoassay (EIA)

#### **Reference Values:**

Adults: < 2.5 ng/mL

# **Specimen Requirements:**

Container/Tube: Red or SST

Preferred: Red Tube

Acceptable: SST Tube

Specimen Volume: 0.8 mL

**Collection Instructions:** Draw blood in a plain red-top tube(s), serum gel tube(s) is acceptable. Spin down

and send 0.8 mL serum, light protected, in a screw-capped vial (Supply T192

amber vial), shipped frozen.

Minimum Volume: 0.5 mL
