# Mycobacterial Culture, Blood

Test ID: CTBBL

**Explanation:** On the effective date, isolator tubes will no longer be an acceptable specimen type for this test.

## **Current Specimen Required**

### Container/Tube:

**Preferred:** Green top (sodium or lithium heparin)

Acceptable: SPS/Isolator System

Specimen Volume: 8 to 10 mL per culture

## **Collection Instructions:**

- 1. Send specimen in original tube.
- 2. Isolator System/SPS tubes are acceptable, but not preferred.
- 3. Draw blood in an Isolator/SPS tube and send 8 mL of whole blood in the original Isolator tube.
- 4. Note: when sending SPS tube, it must be clearly labeled SPS. If label is obscured, sample may be cancelled, as ACD (yellow top) is not an acceptable tube type.

## **New Specimen Required**

### Container/Tube:

**Preferred:** Green top (sodium or lithium heparin)

Acceptable: SPS

Specimen Volume: 8 to 10 mL per culture

# Collection Instructions:

- 1. Send specimen in original tube.
- 2. SPS tubes are acceptable, but not preferred.
- 3. Note: when sending a SPS tube, it must be clearly labeled as SPS. If label is obscured, sample may be cancelled, as ACD (yellow top) is not an acceptable tube type.
