Current Specimen Required

Container/Tube:

Preferred: Grey top (potassium oxalate/sodium fluoride)

Acceptable: Any anticoagulant Specimen Volume: 2 mL

Collection Instructions: Specimen must be sent in

original tube.

New Specimen Required

Container/Tube:

Preferred: Grey top (potassium oxalate/sodium fluoride) **Acceptable:** Lavender top (EDTA) or green top (sodium heparin)

Specimen Volume: 2 mL Collection Instructions:

- **1. Do not use alcohol to clean arm.** Use an alternative, such as Betadine, to cleanse arm before collecting any specimen for volatile testing.
- 2. Specimen must be sent in original tube. **Do not aliquot.**
