Centrifuge, transfer all plasma into a plastic vial, and centrifuge plasma again. Aliquot plasma into a plastic vial, leaving 0.25 mL in the bottom of centrifuged vial. Freeze plasma immediately (no longer than 4 hours after collection) at -20 degrees C or, ideally below -40 degrees C.
