

Oxazepam, Serum

Test ID: OXAZS

Useful for:

- Assessing compliance
- Monitoring for appropriate therapeutic level
- Assessing oxazepam toxicity

Methods:

Liquid Chromatography Tandem Mass Spectrometry (LC-MS/MS)

Reference Values:

Therapeutic concentrations

Oxazepam: 200-1500 ng/mL

Cutoff concentrations by liquid chromatography tandem mass spectrometry:

Oxazepam: 10 ng/mL

Specimen Requirements:

Supplies: Sarstedt Aliquot Tube, 5 mL (T914)

Collection Container/Tube: Red top (Serum gel/SST are not acceptable)

Submission Container/Tube: Plastic vial

Specimen Volume: 1 mL

Specimen Minimum Volume: 0.3 mL

Collection Instructions: Centrifuge and aliquot serum into a plastic vial.
