Explanation: On the effective date, pediatric reference intervals will be added to SSH24. The minimum volume requirement is also being updated.

The enhanced report will also include a pie chart and table labeled “Your Likely Stone Type”. The predicted kidney stone type is determined by using a Mayo-developed model trained on the age, sex, urine chemistry measurements, and supersaturation delta Gibbs values included in the 24-hour urine supersaturation panel.
