

Laboratory Testing for Infectious Causes of Diarrhea for Mayo Clinic¹



¹ This panel should NOT be used for chronic diarrhea.

² Warning signs and risk factors for severe disease include fever, bloody diarrhea, dysentery, severe abdominal pain, dehydration, hospitalization, and immunocompromised state.

- ³ During the summer, consider ordering CRYGI / Cryptosporidium and Giardia Antigen, Feces on children with diarrhea even if they don't have frankly bloody diarrhea, are not toxic-appearing, and diarrhea has been present <7 days.
- ⁴ GI Pathogen Panel tests for common bacterial, viral and parasitic causes of diarrhea
- ⁵ Submit 3 stool collected on separate days for maximum sensitivity

Note: In outbreak scenarios with a known organism, consider ordering a specific test for that organism COCSM / Coccidia Smear, Feces; CRYGI / Cryptosporidium and Giardia Antigen, Feces; bacterial stool culture)
